Dear CANNDU Council leaders,

We're a quick 2 months from the end of the fiscal year! Please be mindful of the Neighborhood Council Funding Program deadlines in early June. Currently, there is \$2.4 million of unspent Neighborhood Council funding, which is two-thirds of the yearly allocation. If your Neighborhood Council needs to spend down funds, please consider contributing to the Congress of Neighborhoods and Neighborhood Council Budget Advocates' work next year since they both serve the entire Neighborhood Council system. Click here for the Board Resolution Form. Next fiscal year, the Mayor's proposed budget provides \$42,000 annual funds per Neighborhood Council. Please have your Neighborhood Council complete the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Strategic Budget Package and submit by July 1, 2017.

Citywide Campaign:

The Mayor's proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 has been released so please have your Neighborhood Council weigh in on it with a Community Impact Statement for <u>Council File 17-0600</u> for the City Council to review. Per the City Charter, Neighborhood Councils are to weigh in on the City budget so your Neighborhood Council can discuss any of the City department's asks, including <u>EmpowerLA's budget request</u>, or the Neighborhood Council Budget Advocates <u>white paper</u> in your CIS.

Administrative Update:

We anticipate the certification of the <u>97th Neighborhood Council</u> by the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners this month - Hermon Neighborhood Council. There is still a pending election challenge for the forming Skid Row Neighborhood Council before the election results are certified.

Funding Updates:

The NC Funding Program is gearing up to close the budget fiscal year in June 2017. Because of the preparation and logistics involved with year-end closing and moving to a new funding system, we are asking the NCs to observe key dates in June. **PLEASE BE REMINDED**: If you have expenses to cover after June 1, 2017, ex. 4th of July event expenses, they must be approved at your May 2017 board meeting AND the Funding Request Form must be received by June 1, 2017. All event submissions must be received 30-days in advance of the event. Board approved emergency expenses after the Bank Card cut-off deadline of June 11, 2017 will be dealt with on a case by case basis and may need to be charged to your 2017/18 budget.

Staff will be assisting with close-out paperwork for NPGs, Events, Community Improvement Projects, etc. We will be holding two NC Funding Trainings in May, one at City Hall and one in South Los Angeles. If a Neighborhood Council is missing 3+ MERs, this Office will assign a contracted vendor to work with the NC at the NC's expense to bring the MERs up to compliance. Finally, we have completed our Citywide round table discussions regarding the new funding system. We will be coordinating a focus group of NC Treasurers to vet some of the specific issues and concerns from the discussions. Field Updates:

We're teaming up with the City Attorney's office to offer 3 Live Ethics Trainings for the month of May. All board members are bound by California State Law to take Ethics Training every two years. Stay tuned for the details to come, and we look forward to seeing you there!
