Many thanks to Controller Ron Galperin, who helped us present the awards, and to the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners for selecting the winners. We're looking forward to seeing next year's applications! The close of the fiscal year is 2-3 board meetings away so please make sure that your Neighborhood Council wraps up all of its funding projects on time. Speaking of funding, Mayor Eric Garcetti will be releasing his proposed budget on April 20th and giving his State of the City address on April 16th at City Hall. We'll provide an update on EmpowerLA and Neighborhood Council funding for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 in our newsletter for that week.

Citywide Campaign:

The Congress of Neighborhoods Planning Committee is starting to plan for this year's Congress on Saturday, September 22, 2018. It takes a lot of people power to plan a great Congress so please step up and support. Administrative Update:

Thank you to the NCs that have participated and assisted us in completing a review of all inventory items. Please remember to keep your items at your NC's office or in a storage space when not being used. Any damaged or obsolete equipment should be salvaged using the City's equipment recycling process. Funding Updates:

Your NC Funding Team is working diligently to ensure that we assist you in a timely manner to review, process and help you spend down your funding allocation, while following all necessary guidelines with respect to public funds. As you know, the end of the fiscal year is quickly approaching and as of now, NCs have approximately \$2,213,678.69 left to spend. NCs have also set aside close to \$200,000 in "commitments", so be mindful to release those funds if they will not be spent so that they can be added to your available cash balance and can be used before the end of the year.

Please remember that our year end dates were announced more than six months in advance and have now been added to our Policies and Guidelines, so that there is no further "element of surprise". A reminder that all those NCs who have special accounts can access those funds now. As mentioned previously, expenditures from any of your special accounts are subject to the requirements in the City's Financial Management System (FMS) and will need a W-9; Itemized Invoice; Vendor's BTRC and a BAC. When uploading your credit card transaction receipts, please do so within 10 days so that you don't run the risk of having your funds frozen.

Field Updates:

Don't forget that the bylaw amendment application deadline is April 15th. The Field team will be working hard to quickly process all applications to ensure that bylaws are locked by July 1st for the City Clerk to start working on elections. The Field team will be working on election outreach for the subdivision applications of North Westwood, Historic Cultural North and Wilshire Center - Little Bangladesh Neighborhood Councils. We'll be holding 4 community meetings per subdivision applications while we work with the Office of the City Clerk on voter registration for a vote-by-mail component. Subdivision elections can be held in late May and June.

Outreach Updates:

The Outreach Team is gearing up for the 2019 Elections. In order to have a robust election, we need to get ready now. We are in the process of creating a Citywide outreach campaign to develop awareness, education, and ways to get involved with Neighborhood Councils. We will be partnering with different organizations, neighborhood council leaders, and all interested parties. We will be working closely with the City Clerk Elections Team to make this happen. More details to come in the next few weeks.

Policy Updates:

The Neighborhood Council Funding Equity Working Group has had a few meetings thus far discussing funding-related Neighborhood Council questions, such as whether individual Council budgets should be proportionate to the number of stakeholders they serve. There has also been discussions as to a floor of funding augmented by population served by a Neighborhood Council as well as discussion on leases, meeting space and translation costs.

Board Members with Expired or Missing Mandatory Trainings

To vote on Neighborhood Council funding items, Neighborhood Council board members must have current ethics training and funding training. The Neighborhood Council bylaws may also require these trainings to vote for nonfunding items as well. To serve on a board, Neighborhood Council board members must also have either read and signed a Code of Conduct or have watched the video. To complete these trainings, please click <u>here</u>.

NOTE: in person and online ethics training must be a minimum of 2 hours. If you complete the ethics training online, please ensure that you take 2 hours to complete the training as we will not accept any certificates that show less than 2 hours.

Board Members who have not completed the Funding training:

Funding - Eligibility to Vote on Financial Matters a. To be eligible to vote on any NC Expenditure, Financial Reports, and/or annual budgets, the board member must:

- Be an Elected, Appointed and/or Selected Board Member of the NC
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have completed the California State Ethics Training Requirement for Local Officials (AB 1234)
- Have completed the online NC Board Member Funding Training and obtain a passing score of 70% on any test associated with the online course.

Board Members with missing or expired Ethics Certificates:

ETHICS - All Board Members are bound by California State Law to take Ethics Training every two years. Take the online course, and send your certificate to <u>Rosters@EmpwerLA.org</u>. Ethics Training is a required for all Board Members

Board Members who have not completed the Code of Conduct training or their certificate has expired:

CODE OF CONDUCT - All Board Members must read the Code of Conduct policy and <u>fill out this form</u> acknowledging that they have read and are aware of the policy.
