Dear CANNDU Council leaders,

Congratulations to our 97th Neighborhood Council - Hermon Neighborhood Council in the East area of Los Angeles! The Board of Neighborhood Commissioners approved the Hermon Neighborhood Council's bylaws last week, which was the last step of the subdivision process. We're looking forward to working with the new board. Hard to believe, but the end of the fiscal year is upon us once again. We're really grateful to Mayor Eric Garcetti and the City Council for investing more resources into the Neighborhood Council next fiscal year. We'll now have resources to provide all Neighborhood Council board members access to the online e-learning platform that City employees have so you'll have on demand access to trainings that will also do real time tracking. The timing of elections next year is still up in the air. We'll be working with the City Clerk on a report back to City Council, which will take into consideration that of the 20 Neighborhood Councils that have weighed in on election timing, 13 are requesting elections to be pushed to 2019. Don't forget to take action on your Strategic Budget Package this month so you get them in on time by July 1st!

Citywide Campaign:

Greg Good, Mayor Eric Garcetti's Chief of Legislative and External Affairs, and Ben Winters from the Mayor's Office of Economic Opportunity, will be visiting the Neighborhood Council regional alliances in June to speak on Council File 17-0274, which would establish an Affordable Housing Linkage Fee for development projects to be placed in a Housing Impact Trust Fund.

Administrative Update:

We've added back Languages 4 You as another translation vendor. One of the reports back from the budget hearings that we need to do is to determine how much translation and interpretation funding each Neighborhood Council needs. We'll be following up with your Neighborhood Council in the next few months to get your feedback on this issue. We'll also be contacting your Neighborhood Council to finalize inventory as we prepare to transfer the lists to the City Clerk for ongoing monitoring.

Funding Updates:

We are rapidly approaching the end of the budget fiscal year 2016-17 and would like to do a final reminder to folks on our key deadlines, please refer to the section on "Dates & Deadlines" in your NC Profile. Please adhere to these deadlines; this timeline is necessary as we must close the books and move to a new funding system. June 8, 2017 is also the last day to send us your screen shots from the bank accounts in order for the Funding Program to be able to reconcile any check payments that have not yet cleared. Please refer to the link (Screen Shots) for proper procedures on how to provide the Funding Program with the screen shots. As an additional reminder, board approved emergency expenses after the bank card cut off deadline of June 11, 2017 will be dealt with on a case by case basis and may need to be charged to your 2017/18 budget. There will be no additional NC Funding training in the month of June as we will be focused on providing training to the NCs on multiple dates, times and locations throughout the City on the new NC Funding system. Please be reminded that our website now contains three (3) new trackers with information related to Contracts; Leases; and MERs.
